## Mother Cabrini celebrations in November

As every year, there was great celebratory excitement throughout the entire Institute, for **the anniversaries of the Founding of the Institute and the Beatification of Mother Cabrini**. At the *St. Frances Cabrini Shrine in New York* the celebrations with various Masses and concerts, began on November 8, 9 and 10 and lasted through November 13 and 14. At the *St. Frances Cabrini Shrine in New York* for the anniversary of the Beatification on the 14<sup>th</sup>, a Mass and a classical music concert was organized. On November 13 at the Cabrini School in

Madrid they celebrated the opening of **the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Cabrini Education in Spain** with a special Mass, followed by a moving procession around the school. It was a beautiful opportunity to remember Mother Cabrini's amazing legacy of love and commitment. The Provincial Superior, Sr. Marta Maria, Emilio Diaz, Regional Secretary of the Catholic Schools of Madrid, and Adolfo Martinez, Technical Director of the *BEDA* (Bilingual English Development & Assessment) program attended.

144 years later, we celebrated the anniversary of the Founding of the Institute on the 13<sup>th</sup>. On the 14<sup>th</sup> we celebrated Mother Cabrini's Beatification 86 years ago and at *Cabrini High School* in New Orleans an activity was organized that involved literally putting ourselves in Mother Cabrini's shoes...or rather in her habit! Students, schoolchildren and faculty took turns in the shoes of our foundress during Mother Cabrini Week celebrations! Also at *Escuela Sagrada Familia No. 1* in Nicaragua they celebrated the 144<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of the Institute of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Novenas were also prayed in several missions of our Institute, such as at *St. Frances Cabrini Shrine* in New York, in Colorado and in the Holy Spirit Region. In Uganda, the celebration started a long time beforehand with the establishment of committees, dance rehearsals, choirs, presentations, food, and the organization of the setting where everything was thought out down to the last detail. It was a beautiful day and the women and all the communities from the Pagirinya refugee camp came to the *Cabrini Center* for the celebration. The Bishop of the Diocese, Rev. Sabino Ocan Odoki, celebrated the Mass and in his homily spoke about what a great woman Mother Cabrini was, expressing his appreciation for her and that the missionaries who are here are the Mother Cabrini's of today. It was an opportunity to get to know the seven communities in which we work, with the particularity of each one. A crowd of women from the groups and projects, children, catechists, authorities and donors danced, sang, made music and created a beautiful celebration for Mother Cabrini. In Italy, a statue of Mother Cabrini was installed and inaugurated on November 13 at the Basilica of San Paolo

# News from Missions and Formation

\* In early November the *San Jose Dispensary Zone 6* in Guatemala held their closing activities for the school year. After a 2024 full of learning, joyful and unforgettable moments, the children of the *Chispa Modificado* program celebrated the closing of the year with a beautiful play in which they taught us the importance of taking care of our health. We thank all the people who made this moment possible.

\* From November 7 to 9, the 17th EC (Escuela Católica) Conference of Catholic Schools in Spain was held in Madrid. Participating were 2,000 people including, as auditors, our General Superior, Sr. Maria Eliane with the leadership team of the Cabrini School.

\* From November 11 to 15, the “Teenagers in Mission” project took place. Pupils from all the Cabrini colleges in Argentina participated with many people contributing to the collection of food, especially non-perishable food.

\* On November 20, Cabrini Immigrant Services of New York and members of Justice for Immigrants joined to launch a program entitled Unemployment Bridge Program (UBP). New York's employment system excludes workers such as freelancers, the self-employed and undocumented immigrants. The UBP is a proposal to guarantee economic stability to more than 750,000 workers who currently have no access to unemployment benefits.

\* On November 28 for Thanksgiving Day at Cabrini Immigrant Services (CIS) in Dobbs Ferry, they organized the STARS (Storytelling, Art, Reading and Socialization) program for young children up to two years old. The theme of the Assembly was Pilgrims of Hope - on the Synodal journey towards Jubilee Year 2025 which guided the reflections and activities during the meetings. We had the joy of being assisted by the Redemptorist missionary, Father Mauro Vilela, the participation of journalist, Camila Morais, and two doctors of Theology. General Superior, Sr. Maria Eliane, and General Assistant, Sr. Stella Maris, also attended the Assembly joining the Provincial Superior, Sr. Rosa, and enriching the moments of sharing and spirituality. The General Superior reflected on the importance of stretching the frontiers and emphasized the challenge of bringing God's message to young people in different parts of the world. The goal is to inspire young people to think of Jesus and act with humanity to the benefit of all people. She emphasized Pope Francis' desire that everyone cultivate a human heart open to good and engaged in actions that promote the common good.

# CABRINI GLOBAL COMMUNICATION

The Holy Year 2025 began in January with the first **Jubilee of the World Communications, which took place from January 24 to 26**. With the occasion of the Jubilee, the first international meeting, “**Cabrini Global Communication**”, was also organized from January 23 and 27.

The meetings on the 23rd and 27th were held at Casa Cabrini on Via Sicilia. There were 15 participants in the working groups with the participation of the General Superior, Sr. Maria Eliane, two General Assistants, Sr. Gilda and Sr. Patricia and the General Secretary, Sr. Giuditta together with her colleague, Claudia, from the Generalate.

**During the first day**, we got to know each other through presentations from the various provinces and the region. Sr. Gloria gave the opening prayer and organized dynamic activity so that we, different realities, could get to know each other better and not just by name. Various pictures of Mother Cabrini were placed on the tables so that anyone who had the same picture could exchange information.

With the help of Sr. Gilda, we then penetrated deeper into Cabrinian spirituality, discovering how great Mother Cabrini had been as a forerunner even in the world of communication. Her talk was entitled “**Cabrinian Missionary Identity in the World of Communications.**”

After lunch together, we listened to the interesting testimony of two journalists from TV Aparecida, Camila Morais and Brother Alan Patrick Zuccherato, who wanted to show us how the national television station they work for also tells about the mission of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in Brazil. At the conclusion of the day, Isabella Sprovieri from Brazil led us in the final

prayer. The next day, **January 24**, with Annamaria and Isabella from the Calypso Association in Rome we visited the Basilica of San Paolo Fuori le Mura. There we shared a moment of prayer in front of the recently inaugurated statue of Mother Cabrini. After a few hours of free time, we met again at the Basilica of San Giovanni in Laterano for the penitential liturgy, presided over by Father Giulio Albanese, director of the Office for Social Communications

of the Vicariate of Rome, and for the Eucharistic Celebration, on the feast of St. Francis de Sales, patron of journalists. The Gospel passage that accompanied us was that of the adulteress (Jn. 8:1-11) and presiding over the celebration was Cardinal Baldo Reina, Vicar General of the Pope for the Diocese of Rome.

On **Saturday January 25** we met very early in the morning at the beginning of Via della Conciliazione in order to make the pilgrimage to the Holy Door together. Together with the English-speaking group, we walked all the way down Via della Conciliazione until we reached the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica. After passing through the Door, we proceeded to the Paul VI Hall and participated in the meeting moderated by journalist Mario Calabresi with testimonies by journalists Maria Ressa and Colum McCann. It was exciting then to witness the entrance of the Pope who wanted to greet as many people as possible.

A good group of our people had lunch together and then split up for the various events organized for the Jubilee in the city of Rome, which each participant had chosen beforehand according to their own interest.

On **Sunday morning, January 26 (Word Sunday)** we participated in the Mass in St. Peter's Basilica with the Holy Father.

On **Monday, January 27**, the meetings resumed at Via Sicilia. The opening prayer was led by Sr. Tatiana. After a little sharing of the previous days spent together, we listened to the talk by Fr. Fabio Pasqualetti SDB, entitled: "Communication as mission. Social Influencers in the Catholic World, Challenges and Opportunities" which helped us reflect on the challenge of communicating today in a complex and changing world. After a moment of dialogue, we had a talk by Sara Braga from the Sisters of the Good Shepherd Foundation, who spoke to us about "How to communicate mission in unity. Practical aspects and guidelines." We worked in groups to be able to set down on paper some of the ideas that had arisen in the previous days on which we could work together even after this meeting. At the conclusion of the day and of the entire Jubilee we had a Eucharistic Celebration of Thanksgiving and a dinner together of pizza and dessert.
